A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Scott Maxwell on the occasion of his retirement; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Scott Maxwell has rendered decades of exceptional service across the public
4 and private sectors, using his extensive media and legislative experience, strategic insight,
5 and relationships with decision-makers at all levels of government to influence public policy
6 and support clients throughout Georgia and beyond; and

7 WHEREAS, he is the founding principal of Mathews & Maxwell Inc., a respected
8 governmental affairs consulting firm he co-founded in 1997 that has twice been named the
9 most effective small governmental affairs firm in Georgia by *James Magazine*; and

10 WHEREAS, during his tenure at Mathews & Maxwell, he has led the development of short-
11 and long-term strategies to help clients achieve success in legislative, procurement, and
12 regulatory matters, representing sectors such as agribusiness, construction, healthcare,
13 manufacturing, transportation, and state procurement; and
