- 1 Recognizing February 9-15, 2025, as National FBLA Week; and for other purposes.

3 organization whose first chapter was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in 1942; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Iowa became FBLA's first state chapter in 1947; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Johns Creek High School officially chartered its FBLA local chapter on August  
6 28, 2009; and
- 7 WHEREAS, FBLA includes more than 250,000 members and advisers in 4,600 chapters  
8 nationwide in middle schools, high schools, colleges, universities, career and technical  
9 schools, and private business schools; and
- 10 WHEREAS, FBLA is a professional business organization dedicated to bringing business  
11 and education together in a positive working relationship through innovative leadership and  
12 career development programs; and

13 WHEREAS, FBLA members perform community service activities and strive to build  
14 students' understanding of the realities of the modern business world; and

15 WHEREAS, FBLA teaches middle school, high school, and college students basic business  
16 and leadership principles and assists them in the transition from school to work.

18 the members of this body recognize February 9-15, 2025, as National FBLA Week.
