## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Trooper Jimmy Cenescar and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Trooper Jimmy Cenescar was highly regarded by the citizens of his community  
4 and state and by local government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity and  
5 dedication to the sound principles of law enforcement; and

6 WHEREAS, Trooper Cenescar was born in Port Au Prince, Haiti, on August 8, 1995, the  
7 beloved son of Helas and Wisleine Cenescar; and

8 WHEREAS, he began his career in law enforcement with the Atlanta Police Department,  
9 where he earned recognition and honors for his 2022 rescue of a driver who had driven off  
10 a bridge; and

11 WHEREAS, Trooper Cenescar joined the Department of Public Safety and graduated from  
12 the 114th Georgia State Patrol Trooper School in 2023 and exhibited extraordinary devotion  
13 to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his  
14 duties; and

15 WHEREAS, Trooper Cenescar's life was tragically cut short in the line of duty on  
16 January 28, 2024; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
18 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
20 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on State Route 324 over Interstate 85 in  
21 Gwinnett County is dedicated as the Trooper Jimmy Cenescar Memorial Bridge.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Trooper Jimmy Cenescar  
24 Memorial Bridge.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
27 family of Trooper Jimmy Cenescar and to the Department of Transportation.
