1 Commending Joseph Williams of Alpharetta High School for winning the 2024 GHSA 6A
2 Individual Track and Field State Championship in the 110m hurdles; and for other purposes.

4 proud tradition of excellence with equal emphases on character and academics; and

5 WHEREAS, this superlative athlete has completed a triumphant season of track competition
6 that included several prestigious invitationals and meets; and

8 Williams a spectacular runner to observe throughout the season, and as a fitting finale to his
9 remarkable 2024 campaign, Joseph Williams captured the state championship in the 110m
10 hurdles with a time of 14.11 seconds, becoming the first state champion in the 110m hurdles
