## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Vincent Nnanna of Alpharetta High School for winning the 2024 GHSA 6A  
2 Individual Track and Field State Championship in the 300m hurdles; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Vincent Nnanna, a junior at Alpharetta High School, has maintained the  
4 school's proud tradition of excellence with equal emphases on character and academics; and

5 WHEREAS, this superlative athlete has completed a triumphant season of track competition  
6 that included several prestigious invitationals and meets; and

7 WHEREAS, excellent skill, superior fitness, and extraordinary resilience made Vincent  
8 Nnanna a spectacular runner to observe throughout the season, and as a fitting finale to his  
9 remarkable 2024 campaign, Vincent Nnanna captured the state championship in the 300m  
10 hurdles with a time of 37.11 seconds, becoming the first state champion in the 300m hurdles  
11 at Alpharetta High School since 2021, and

12 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of Vincent Nnanna is a clear indication of his  
13 outstanding athletic ability, dedication, hard work, and his fighting spirit; his superb  
14 discipline and commitment to track; and the astute direction of Head Coach AJ Merine; and

16 by performing with confidence, grit, and precision over months of training, conditioning, and  
17 competition, it is abundantly proper to call him a champion.
