Senators Burns of the 23rd, Brass of the 6th, and Cowser of the 46th offered the following amendment #1:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Rules substitute to HB 483 (LC 49 2400S) by replacing lines*
2 *1 and 2 with "To amend Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to*
3 *crimes and offenses, so as to provide for protections for inspectors of code enforcement; to*
4 *provide for enhanced penalties in certain circumstances; to replace a term; to repeal an". By*
5 *inserting between lines 9 and 10 "Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,*
6 *relating to crimes and offenses, is amended by adding a new paragraph to Code Section*
7 *16-5-19, relating to definitions, to read as follows: "(4.1) 'Inspector of code enforcement' or*
8 *'inspector' means any person with a high school diploma or equivalent who has completed*
9 *Level 1 code enforcement training under a professional program and is employed by or under*
10 *contract with a municipality, city, county, or consolidated government who performs safety*
11 *inspections of buildings, structures, and businesses to ensure they are operated in accordance*
12 *with the law." SECTION 2. Said title is further amended by replacing "utility worker while*
13 *such worker" with "utility worker or inspector of code enforcement while such worker or*
14 *inspector" wherever the former term appears in Chapter 5, relating to crimes against a person.*
15 *SECTION 3.". By replacing lines 10 -11 until "amended" with "Said title is further". By*
16 *replacing "part" on line 18 with "title". By redesignating Sections 2, 3, and 4 as Sections 4,*
17 *5, and 6.*
