A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance, so as to
2 include certain relatives within mammogram coverage criteria for females at risk for breast
3 cancer; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to
4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance, is amended by
8 revising paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section 33-29-3.2, relating to coverage of
9 mammograms, Pap smears, and prostate-specific antigen tests, and notice of coverage, as
10 follows:

11 "(1) 'Female at risk' means a woman:

12 (A) Who has a personal history of breast cancer;

13 (B) Who has a personal history of biopsy proven benign breast disease;

14 (C) ~~Whose grandmother, mother, sister, or daughter~~ Who has one or more first or
15 second degree relatives who has had breast cancer; or

16 (D) Who has not given birth prior to age 30."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 Said title is further amended by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section
19 33-30-4.2, relating to insurance coverage for mammograms, Pap smears, and
20 prostate-specific antigen tests, as follows:

21 "(1) 'Female at risk' means a woman:

22 (A) Who has a personal history of breast cancer;

23 (B) Who has a personal history of biopsy proven benign breast disease;

24 (C) ~~Whose grandmother, mother, sister, or daughter~~ Who has one or more first or
25 second degree relatives who has had breast cancer; or

26 (D) Who has not given birth prior to age 30."

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2025, and shall apply to all policies or contracts
29 issued, delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this state on or after such date.

30 **SECTION 4.**

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
