

Senate Bill 385

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 general provisions regarding the General Assembly, so as to provide for the abolishment of  
3 the office of administration floor leaders; to make conforming changes; to provide for related  
4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general  
8 provisions regarding the General Assembly, is amended by revising subsection (a) of Code  
9 Section 28-1-8, relating to salary and allowances of members and officers, as follows:

10 "(a) Each member of the General Assembly shall receive an annual salary, as provided for  
11 in Code Section 45-7-4, to be paid in equal monthly installments. Upon complying with  
12 the requirements of paragraph (22) of subsection (a) of Code Section 45-7-4, each member  
13 shall also be reimbursed for those actual expenses incurred in the performance of duties for  
14 which reimbursement is provided in paragraph (22) of subsection (a) of Code Section  
15 45-7-4. The Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Speaker Pro Tempore of the  
16 House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall receive an

17 additional amount per annum as provided for in Code Section 45-7-4. The majority leader,  
18 and the minority leader, ~~the administration floor leader, and the assistant administration~~  
19 ~~floor leaders~~ of the House of Representatives and the majority leader, and the minority  
20 leader, ~~the administration floor leader, and the assistant administration floor leaders~~ of the  
21 Senate shall each receive such additional amount per annum as shall be provided by  
22 resolution of the respective houses; but such amount for each shall not be greater than the  
23 additional amount provided by law for the Speaker Pro Tempore of the House of  
24 Representatives. All of such additional amounts shall also be paid in equal monthly  
25 installments."

## SECTION 2.

27 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

28 "28-1-18.

29 There shall be no office in the House of Representatives or Senate named administration  
30 floor leader or assistant administration floor leader. No member of the General Assembly,  
31 in his or her capacity as a member, shall be granted special privileges, including additional  
32 salary or office space, by virtue of having been named to an office or position by the  
33 Governor."

## SECTION 3.

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
