

Senate Bill 390

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to general provisions of state military generally, so as to prohibit the
3 deployment of armed military forces of other states into this state without the permission of
4 the Governor; to provide for an exception; to provide for other matters; to repeal conflicting
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
9 relating to general provisions of state military generally, is amended by adding a new Code
10 section to read as follows:

11 "38-2-13.

12 (a) No armed military forces from another state, territory, or district shall enter this state
13 for the purpose of performing any military duty without the permission of the Governor.

14 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply to armed military
15 forces that are in the service of the United States and are acting under authority that is
16 validly invoked by the President of the United States."

SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
