A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. John L. Williams and dedicating an interchange in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. John L. Williams has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for
4 the vital role that he played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Williams diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his
7 time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his work as an entrepreneur in Cook County, Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Williams' significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable
10 patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the
11 citizens of this state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
14 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an interchange in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the interchange of State Route 401/Interstate 75 and State
19 Route 37 in Cook County is dedicated as the John L. Williams Memorial Interchange.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the John L. Williams Memorial
22 Interchange.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
25 family of Mr. John L. Williams and to the Department of Transportation.
