- 6 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her husband, Darrell Bartlett, and was
7 blessed with three remarkable children, Ben, Joseph, and Patrick; and two wonderful
8 grandchildren, Isla and Eden; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Claire Ann Bartlett has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable
10 hours of her time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as
11 evidenced dramatically by her superlative service as founder of Fulton County Republican
12 Women, her dedicated work as Precinct Chairman, House District Chairman, and Executive
13 Director of the Fulton County Republican Party, and her outstanding leadership with
14 Georgia's National Right to Life affiliate and Georgia Life Alliance; and
