- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Deputy Joe Crumpton; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Deputy Joe Crumpton on December 9, 2025; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Deputy Joe Crumpton served his community for over two years as a member
5 of the Spalding County Sheriff's Office, where he was part of the Detention Division and
6 held the role of transport officer; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he further served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the
8 United States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Rose, and was blessed to be the
10 father of seven wonderful children; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
12 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
13 family and friends were admired by others; and

14 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
15 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
16 made this world a better place in which to live; and

17 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Deputy Joe Crumpton will long be
18 remembered for his inspiring commitment to the welfare of others, which stands as a shining
19 example of the positive effect law enforcement professionals have on the lives and well-
20 being of others.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 join in honoring the life and memory of Deputy Joe Crumpton and express their deepest and
23 most sincere regret at his passing.
