- 2 WHEREAS, Keith B. Winslow began his illustrious career in the music and entertainment
3 industry in 1969, starting out as the valet and road manager for rock-n-roll legend Little
4 Richard; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was a skilled salesman and promoter, known for his tireless dedication and
6 vast knowledge of entertainment across all genres of music and broadcasting networks; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Keith B. Winslow was know as loved as “The Boss of the Beach” as the disc
8 jockey at WPIQ (101Q) and WKBX radio at the Kings Bay Submarine Base in Brunswick,
9 Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 2022, Keith was inducted into the National Black Radio Hall of Fame in St.
11 Louis, in recognition of life-long dedication to radio broadcasting; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Keith Winslow passed away unexpectedly on October 7, 2025, forever being
13 remembered for his dedication to his work and as “The Boss of the Beach.”
