A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring His Most Eminence, Prophet (Dr.) Emmanuel Adewale Abiodun Alogbo; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, His Most Eminence, Prophet (Dr.) Emmanuel Adewale Abiodun Alogbo was
4 born on Easter Sunday, April 16, 1933, on Victoria Island, Lagos State, to the family of the
5 late Dickson Adeleye Alogbo and Maria Ojubomo Alogbo; and

6 WHEREAS, growing up he was surrounded by music as his father was the choirmaster at
7 Hoare Methodist Church; and

8 WHEREAS, in 1959, while working with the Nigeria Railway Corporation in Zaria. as fate
9 would have it, he heard the Cherubim and Seraphim Movement Church choir singing a hymn
10 he had composed during his time as a member of the choir of United Methodist African
11 Church; and

12 WHEREAS, this marked the beginning of his spiritual journey and contributions to the
13 church's music ministry as well as his faith driven and devoted membership to the Cherubim
14 and Seraphim Movement Church; and

15 WHEREAS, in 1960, Brother Emmanuel Alogbo returned to Lagos where he was inspired
16 by God and established the first branch of the Cherubim and Seraphim Movement Church
17 in Lagos, the south of the River Niger, thereby becoming the architect of the founding
18 Cherubim and Seraphim Movement Church in Southern Nigeria; and

19 WHEREAS, Prophet (Dr.) Emmanuel Abiodun Alogbo introduced innovations that greatly
20 enriched worship in the Cherubim and Seraphim Movement Church including bringing a
21 dance-music style to services; and

22 WHEREAS, on September 20, 2025, His Most Eminence, Prophet (Dr) Emmanuel Abiodun
23 Adewale Alogbo was appointed the Supreme Head (Olori) and assumed the leadership of
24 Cherubim and Seraphim Unification Church of Nigeria (otherwise known as Unification) -
25 an umbrella body for all Cherubim and Seraphim Churches all over the world.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 honor His Most Eminence, Prophet (Dr.) Emmanuel Adewale Abiodun Alogbo and extend
28 sincere best wishes for his continued health and happiness.
