A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 10, 2026, as Fayette Chamber Day at the Capitol in conjunction with
2 the Fayette Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Fayette program; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, started by the Fayette Chamber of Commerce in 1980, Leadership Fayette
4 strives to empower and encourage a diverse group of existing and emerging leaders that are
5 prepared and committed to serving Fayette County; and

6 WHEREAS, Leadership Fayette is a hands-on program that provides opportunities for
7 individuals to enhance their civic knowledge of Fayette County, hone their leadership skills,
8 and network with leaders across the community; and

9 WHEREAS, through Leadership Fayette participants gain an in-depth view of critical issues
10 facing thier community; personal leadership skills, awareness, and development; access to
11 opportunities for community involvement; opportunities to discuss key issues with
12 community leaders; as well as new, strengthened relationships with peers; and

13 WHEREAS, on February 10, 2026, participants in the Leadership Fayette program will visit
14 to the Georgia State Capitol to learn about the legislative process and engage with state
15 leaders; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this outstanding program is appropriately
17 honored.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize February 10, 2026, as Fayette Chamber Day at the Capitol in conjunction with the
20 Fayette Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Fayette program.
