A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and honoring the City of Tucker, Georgia, on the occasion of its 10th
2 anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the City of Tucker, Georgia, was officially incorporated on November 3, 2015,
4 following approval by referendum of its residents, thereby becoming one of the newest
5 municipalities in DeKalb County and the State of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, since its incorporation, the City of Tucker has embodied the principles of local
7 self-governance, civic engagement, and responsible stewardship, reflecting the determination
8 and vision of its citizens; and

9 WHEREAS, the City of Tucker is grounded in a rich history of commerce, transportation,
10 faith communities, and civic involvement and has built upon that legacy to promote
11 economic development, enhance public safety, improve infrastructure, and expand
12 recreational and cultural opportunities; and

13 WHEREAS, during its first decade, the City of Tucker has demonstrated steady progress
14 through thoughtful planning, collaborative leadership, and a continued commitment to

15 improving the quality of life for its residents while preserving the character of its
16 neighborhoods; and

17 WHEREAS, the success of the City of Tucker is due in large measure to the dedicated
18 service of its mayor and city council, past and present, city staff, volunteers, business leaders,
19 and engaged residents who have worked collectively to advance the city's growth and
20 prosperity; and

21 WHEREAS, the 10th anniversary of the City of Tucker provides a fitting opportunity to
22 recognize its accomplishments, commend its leadership and citizens, and acknowledge its
23 contributions to DeKalb County and the state of Georgia.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body recognize and honor the City of Tucker, Georgia, on the occasion
26 of its 10th anniversary and extend best wishes for continued success, progress, and service
27 to its citizens.
