3 with the passing of Joshua Gerard Cardiello on January 5, 2026; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Joshua Gerard Cardiello was born on March 24, 1995, a beloved son, brother,
5 husband, and father; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Joshua Gerard Cardiello was an active member
7 of Gwinnett Church and North Point Community Church; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Allison, and was blessed and
9 proud to be the father of a remarkable daughter, Amelia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his strength, loyalty, generosity of spirit,
11 and deep love for family, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to
12 his family and friends were admired by others; and

13 WHEREAS, Joshua Gerard Cardiello was a passionate advocate for youth heart screening
14 to help prevent sudden cardiac arrest, and played an instrumental role in establishing a
15 partnership with the organization Who We Play For, to provide free heart screening in
16 Gwinnett County, where Joshua and his brother both attended high school; and

17 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
18 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
19 made this world a better place in which to live; and

20 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Joshua Gerard Cardiello will long be
21 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
22 had the great fortune of knowing him.
