A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the City of Tucker upon its 10th anniversary and recognizing May 2, 2026,
2 as Tucker Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

4 of Tucker with a 73 percent vote in favor of the incorporation; and

5 WHEREAS, in March of 2016, the inaugural mayor and council were elected to serve the
6 City of Tucker; and

7 WHEREAS, the City of Tucker is the result of years of volunteers supporting and uplifting
8 the community and residents, including those that dedicated their time to the pursuit of
9 incorporation; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2026 the City of Tucker celebrates ten years of successful governance, fiscal
11 responsibility, and economic growth; and

12 WHEREAS, over the past ten years, the City of Tucker has expanded and improved the level
13 of service to the residents and business owners; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that Tucker Day is celebrated at the state
15 capitol in acknowledgment of the outstanding government and community in the City of
