A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing June 7, 2026, as TIUA School of Business Entrepreneur Day; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, entrepreneurship serves as a vital force in driving innovation, fostering
4 economic growth, and creating sustainable opportunities for communities locally, nationally,
5 and globally; and

6 WHEREAS, the TIUA School of Business, a distinguished institution of Trinity International
7 University of Ambassadors (TUIA), has consistently demonstrated a strong commitment to
8 equipping leaders, professionals, and innovators with the skills, tools, and knowledge
9 necessary to excel in entrepreneurship, business development, and leadership; and

10 WHEREAS, the TIUA School of Business celebrates the entrepreneurial spirit as a powerful
11 catalyst for strengthening communities, advancing creativity, promoting financial
