A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 2, 2026, as Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, Day at the State
2 Capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, was founded at Howard University
4 in Washington, D.C., on January 15, 1908, and has the distinction of being the first sorority
5 established by African American college women for African American college women; and

6 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. has expanded to more than 1,115 chapters
7 world-wide, with Georgia serving as host to approximately 70 of those chapters on college
8 and university campuses as well as numerous active alumnae communities around the state
9 with over 10,672 active Georgia Members; and

10 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. is committed to community service and
11 actively contributes to the educational, civic, health, and socioeconomic life of Georgia's
12 citizens; and

13 WHEREAS, all chapters are encouraging their members to become involved community
14 volunteers and community advocates, and their primary service components include

15 Empower our Families, Build Our Economic Wealth, Enhance Our Environment, Advocate
16 for Social Justice, and Uplift our Local Community; and

17 WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. Day at the State Capitol is an international
18 program developed for members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. to meet with their
19 legislators and to discuss issues that are pertinent to strengthening families and communities;

21 WHEREAS, at the direction of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc.'s International President
22 Mrs. Danette Reed; South Atlantic Region Director the Honorable Tiffany Moore Russell
23 Esq.; South Atlantic Region Representative of the International Connection and Social
24 Action Committee Ms. Cassandra K. Ward, Esq.; the Georgia Connection and Social Action
25 Coordinator Mrs. Myesha Good; Alpha Kappa Alpha Day at the capitol Chairmen Sydney
26 Jakes and Akear Mewborn; and Georgia Connection and Social Action liaisons the
27 Honorable House Minority Leader Carolyn Hugley, the Honorable Dar'shun Kendrick, the
28 Honorable Inga Willis and the Honorable Anissa Jones have convened this delegation for the
29 purpose of civic engagement and community involvement, exemplifying the theme
30 "SOARing to the Midterms: Voting for Change!"
