A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 10, 2026, as Omega Day at the Georgia State Capitol; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., founded on November 17, 1911, at Howard
4 University, holds the distinction of being the first African-American Greek-letter fraternity
5 established at a Historically Black College or University; and

6 WHEREAS, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., has, for more than a century, demonstrated an
7 unwavering commitment to leadership, scholarship, community Uplift, and civic engagement
8 across the nation and throughout the State of Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, members of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., across the State of Georgia, under
10 the leadership of Omega Psi Phi Georgia State Representative Timothy Block, annually
11 convene in the State Capitol City of Atlanta for a Legislative Workshop designed to
12 strengthen their role as advocates for critical urban, rural, family, military, and collegiate
13 legislative issues; and

14 WHEREAS, this annual gathering provides an opportunity for Omega men to meet with key
15 legislation sponsors and co-sponsors to receive updates, exchange ideas, and develop

16 strategies for how the fraternity can continue to play a meaningful role in shaping policy and
17 supporting communities throughout Georgia; and

18 WHEREAS, the 2026 Omega Day at the Capitol will be observed on Tuesday, February 10,
19 2026, marking a significant occasion to recognize the fraternity's contributions to the State
20 of Georgia and its continued dedication to legislative engagement and community
21 advancement.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body recognize and commend Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., for its
24 continued civic progress and human welfare advocacy at Omega Day at the Capitol and
25 extend best wishes for a productive and impactful Legislative Workshop and continued
26 service to the citizens of Georgia.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body recognize February 10, 2026,
28 as Omega Day at the Georgia State Capitol.
