A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating and commending Raising Expectations; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Raising Expectations will be celebrating 30 years of dedicated community
3 service, empowering and supporting youth facing significant systemic and economic
4 challenges; and
- 5 WHEREAS, under the guiding hand and sustained leadership of co-founders Maria
6 Armstrong and Tangee Allen, this outstanding non-profit organization has served over 3,500
7 youth, all of whom qualify for free or reduced price meals and are first-generation college
8 students; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Raising Expectations delivers a comprehensive continuum of academic,
10 leadership, and college-to-career programming designed to support students over multiple
11 years and through key life transitions; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Rising Expectations' core programing focuses on sustained, month-by-month
13 engagement, following students from middle school through college and transition into the
14 workforce; and

15 WHEREAS, in addition to core programs, Raising Expectations offers enrichment initiatives
16 including the Summer Pathfinder Workforce Programs, the Real Estate Enrichment Program,
17 Take a Student to College Day, and literacy programs, expanding access to experiences and
18 opportunities often unavailable to students from under-resourced communities; and

19 WHEREAS, this remarkable organization's work strengthens not only individual students,
20 but families, neighborhoods, and the broader Atlanta community; and

21 WHEREAS, Raising Expectations' legacy is defined by its belief in what is possible when
22 youth are met with consistency, care, and high expectations—and by its continued
23 commitment to fueling the future, one student at a time.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 congratulate Rising Expectations upon 30 years of impact, commend it for its many
26 outstanding contributions on behalf of the citizens of Georgia, and extend best wishes for its
27 continued growth, development, and success.
