A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce and recognizing February 5, 2026,
2 as Clayton Chamber Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce, founded in 1953, is a
4 member-based nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting business growth and enhancing
5 the quality of life through economic prosperity; and

6 WHEREAS, the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce unites business and professional
7 individuals by empowering local growth, improving business to business networking and
8 helping to strengthen our community; and

9 WHEREAS, the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce continues to provide leadership and
10 educational opportunities with their program, Leadership Clayton, a leadership development
11 program established in 1972 that has engaged over 1000 emerging and existing leaders in a
12 ten-month program that broadens their knowledge of community issues, sharpens their
13 leadership skills, and challenges themselves and others to seek solutions to those issues
14 affecting our communities; and

15 WHEREAS, Chamber members are invited to participate each year in the Clayton County
16 Chamber of Commerce Day at the state capitol to meet with our state leaders during the
17 legislative session, discuss legislative priorities that are important to their business and the
18 County as well as see our state government in action.
