A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 5, 2026, as YouthBuild Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, YouthBuild is a nationally recognized education and workforce development
3 program serving young adults ages 16-24 who face barriers to education and employment;

5 WHEREAS, the program plays a critical role in preparing young people for sustainable
6 careers and civic engagement by allowing participants to earn their high school diploma, or
7 equivalent, while receiving hands-on job training, leadership development, and opportunities
8 for community service; and

9 WHEREAS, in Atlanta, YouthBuild is supported by the Atlanta Department of Labor and
10 Employment Services, which is committed to strengthening the local workforce by
11 expanding access to labor education, job training, and employment pathways; and

12 WHEREAS, through this partnership, YouthBuild participants gain industry-relevant skills
13 that align with labor market needs while contributing positively to their communities; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this outstanding organization be
15 appropriately honored.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body recognize February 5, 2026, as YouthBuild Day at the capitol.
