A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Georgia Association of Community Care Providers; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Association of Community Care Providers (GACCP) represents
4 home and community-based service providers across the state of Georgia who deliver
5 compassionate, high-quality care to individuals with disabilities, complex care needs, and
6 aging populations; and

7 WHEREAS, GACCP member providers deliver essential services through Medicaid waiver
8 programs including, but not limited to, the ICWP, EDWP, NOW, and COMP waivers,
9 allowing individuals to receive personalized care in their homes and communities rather than
10 in institutional settings; and

11 WHEREAS, these providers serve communities throughout Georgia, with a significant
12 number operating in underserved and rural areas where access to care is limited and
13 community-based providers are often the primary source of support for individuals and
14 families; and

15 WHEREAS, home and community-based services promote independence, dignity, and
16 quality of life by empowering individuals to remain connected to their families,
17 neighborhoods, and communities while receiving the care they need; and

18 WHEREAS, these providers allow Georgians to live at home for as long as possible outside
19 of institutional settings and therefore at great savings to taxpayers; and

20 WHEREAS, the commitment, professionalism, and compassion of GACCP providers and
21 their workforce are vital to maintaining a stable, accessible, and effective system of care that
22 supports thousands of Georgians and their families each day.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize and commend the Georgia Association of Community
25 Care Providers for its continued commitment to providing compassionate, high-quality care
26 to individuals with disabilities, complex care needs, and aging populations.
