### A RESOLUTION

- 5 WHEREAS, this week highlights the enormous impact that school counselors make in  
6 helping students reach their goals; and
- 7 WHEREAS, school counselors are employed in public and private schools to help students  
8 reach their full potential and are actively committed to helping students explore their  
9 interests, abilities, strengths, and talents relating to development and career awareness; and
- 10 WHEREAS, school counselors help parents focus on ways to further the educational,  
11 personal, and social growth of their children and work with teachers and other educators to  
12 help students explore their potential and set realistic goals for themselves; and

13 WHEREAS, school counselors seek to identify and utilize community resources that can  
14 enhance and complement comprehensive school counseling programs to help students  
15 become productive members of society; and

16 WHEREAS, comprehensive school counseling programs are considered an integral part of  
17 the educational process, which enables all students to achieve success in school.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body recognize National School Counseling Week at the state capitol.
