A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act creating the Garden City Area Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority,  
2 approved May 17, 2004 (Ga. L. 2004, p. 3983); to provide for the assets and liabilities  
3 thereof; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act creating the Garden City Area Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority, approved  
7 May 17, 2004 (Ga. L. 2004, p. 3983), is hereby repealed in its entirety.

8 **SECTION 2.**

9 Any and all assets of the Garden City Area Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority shall  
10 devolve automatically and without further action to Garden City, Georgia, subject to any  
11 restrictions provided by law. The City Council of Garden City, Georgia, is authorized to  
12 execute any deeds or instruments of conveyance required to place title of such assets into the  
13 name of Garden City and is authorized to do so in the name of the Garden City Area  
14 Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority. The obligations of the Garden City Area  
15 Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority shall be transferred to and assumed by Garden

16 City, Georgia, by such instruments as may be required to maintain the same. The City  
17 Council of Garden City, Georgia, is authorized to execute any such instruments required to  
18 transfer such obligations into the name of Garden City and is authorized to do so in the name  
19 of the Garden City Area Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority.

**SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
