A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Public Policy Club at Georgia State University for its commitment to civic
2 engagement, public service, and policy education; and for other purposes.

4 meaningful opportunities to engage with public policy, governance, and the legislative
5 process at the local, state, and national levels; and

6 WHEREAS, the club serves as a nonpartisan forum for discussion, education, and
7 collaboration on pressing public policy issues affecting the State of Georgia and beyond; and

8 WHEREAS, members of the Public Policy Club actively promote civic participation by
9 encouraging student involvement in advocacy, public service, and democratic processes; and

10 WHEREAS, the organization fosters professional development by connecting students with
11 policymakers, public servants, community leaders, and policy professionals through events,
12 discussions, and experiential learning opportunities; and

13 WHEREAS, the Public Policy Club contributes to Georgia State University's mission as an
14 urban research institution by engaging students in policy discussions that reflect the diverse
15 communities of metropolitan Atlanta and the State of Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, the club's activities cultivate informed, engaged citizens who are prepared to
17 contribute thoughtfully and responsibly to public discourse and policymaking; and

18 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to recognize student organizations that strengthen civic
19 education, encourage public engagement, and promote thoughtful analysis of public policy
20 issues.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend and recognize the Public Policy Club at Georgia State
23 University for its dedication to civic engagement, public policy education, and service to the
24 student body and the broader community.
