## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and congratulating SkillsUSA Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, SkillsUSA is a national nonprofit organization serving students preparing for  
3 careers in trade, technical, skilled service, and professional occupations; and
- 4 WHEREAS, SkillsUSA Georgia is the chartered state association representing the  
5 organization across the State of Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, SkillsUSA Georgia supports career, technical, and agricultural education by  
7 empowering students to become career-ready leaders through hands-on learning, leadership  
8 development, and the application of academic and technical skills; and
