1 Honoring Officer Brantley Worley; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Officer Brantley Worley faithfully serves the state of Georgia as the Captain
3 of McCaysville Police Department and a member of Pickens County Fire and Rescue; and

4 WHEREAS, his ability to serve simultaneously in law enforcement, firefighting, and
5 emergency medical responses demonstrates his unwavering commitment to the welfare and
6 safety of the citizens of the state of Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, on the night of September 12, 2025, Officer Worley sustained life threatening
8 injuries, including a fractured C1 vertebrae, broken nose, and a brain bleed, after being shot
9 in the back of the head while in the line of duty; and

10 WHEREAS, the actions Officer Worley during this incident exemplify courage, selflessness,
11 and steadfast commitment to protecting others, even at great personal risk; and

12 WHEREAS, such sacrifices highlight the dangers faced daily by law enforcement officers
13 and first responders as well as the profound responsibility they carry in safeguarding our
