A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 20-2-2068.1, relating to charter school funding, so as to require local
2 boards of education to treat local charter schools no less favorably than other local schools
3 with respect to the expenditure of the proceeds of a special purpose local option sales tax for
4 education; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Code Section 20-2-2068.1, relating to charter school funding, is amended by adding a new
8 subsection to read as follows:

9 "(c.4) A local board of education shall treat a local charter school no less favorably than
10 other local schools within the applicable local school system with respect to the
11 expenditure of the proceeds of a sales tax for educational purposes authorized by
12 Article VIII, Section VI, Paragraph IV of the Constitution of Georgia."

13 SECTION 2.

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
