## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 24, 2026, as ERA day in the state of Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, women in Georgia and in the United States have continuously worked to gain  
3 full rights and privileges— public or private, legal or institutional— as citizens of the United  
4 States, and
- 5 WHEREAS, women in Georgia, and in every state, worked to secure women's right to vote  
6 among other significant milestones in equal rights; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it is critical to remember the trailblazers that made it possible for women to  
8 vote, and it is vital to teach the history and hear the voices of the women who persist in  
9 telling their stories; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the work of past and present Suffragists and Equal Rights Amendment  
11 Advocates, including the League of Women Voters, the Georgia Women's Legislative  
12 Caucus, and so many more have contributed and continue to contribute to the protection of  
13 equal rights for women; and

14 WHEREAS, ERA Day highlights the ongoing need for equality in various aspects of life,  
15 including economic security, reproductive health, and political representation; and

16 WHEREAS, recognizing ERA Day as a day of celebration throughout the state of Georgia  
17 and the country emphasizes the importance of women's work for democracy and equal rights.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body recognize February 24, 2026, as ERA day in support of women's  
20 equality in Georgia and across our nation.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
22 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
23 public and the press.
