A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia's lineworkers and recognizing April 13, 2026, as Georgia Lineworker
2 Appreciation Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the profession of a lineworker is steeped in personal, family, and professional
4 tradition; and

5 WHEREAS, lineworkers are often first responders during storms and other catastrophic
6 events, working to make the scene safe for other public safety heroes; and

7 WHEREAS, lineworkers work with thousands of volts of electricity high atop power lines
8 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, to keep electricity flowing; and

9 WHEREAS, lineworkers must often work under dangerous conditions far from their families
10 to construct and maintain the energy infrastructure of this state; and

11 WHEREAS, lineworkers put their lives on the line every day with little recognition from the
12 community regarding the danger of their work; and

13 WHEREAS, it is most fitting and proper that the lineworkers of Georgia be recognized for
14 their effective and dedicated service to the people of the State of Georgia.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 commend Georgia's lineworkers for their efforts in keeping the power on and protecting
17 public safety and recognize April 13, 2026, as Georgia Lineworker Appreciation Day at the
18 state capitol.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
21 press.
