A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Logan Crosby for his professional achievements and
2 contributions to the State of Georgia and the arts; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Logan Crosby was born in Macon, Georgia, and raised in Milledgeville,
4 Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, Logan Crosby is a graduate of the University of Georgia, where he earned a
6 degree in political science; and

7 WHEREAS, during his collegiate career, Logan Crosby gained hands-on experience in
8 public service, working with Senator Ricky Williams, Representative Houston Gaines, and
9 the administration of Governor Brian Kemp, building a foundation in government operations,
10 constituent services, and campaign work; and

11 WHEREAS, in addition to his public service experience, Logan Crosby also worked with
12 Williams Funeral Home under Senator Ricky Williams, further strengthening his connection
13 to community service and local leadership; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2022, Logan Crosby competed on the inaugural season of ABC's Claim to
15 Fame, where he earned second place and gained national recognition; and

16 WHEREAS, following his television appearance, Logan Crosby relocated to Nashville,
17 Tennessee, to pursue a full-time career in music; and

18 WHEREAS, Logan Crosby is now an independent recording artist whose music blends pop,
19 rock, soul, and country influences, and he has toured extensively across the United States;

21 WHEREAS, he has released multiple original projects and is currently on his third headlining
22 tour, continuing to expand his audience through authentic songwriting and live performances;

24 WHEREAS, Logan Crosby's unique journey from public service to the arts reflects the
25 diverse talents fostered in Georgia and serves as an inspiration to young professionals
26 pursuing both civic engagement and creative endeavors.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 recognize and commend Logan Crosby for his accomplishments in public service and music,
29 and congratulate him on his continued success as a recording artist.
