A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 9 to 13, 2026, as Georgia Donor Week at the state capitol; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, organ donation is a lifesaving and life-enhancing gift, offering hope and healing
4 to the thousands of individuals awaiting transplants each year; and

5 WHEREAS, more than 100,000 people in the United States are currently on the national
6 transplant waiting list; and

7 WHEREAS, a single donor can save up to eight lives, restore sight to two individuals, and
8 improve the lives of more than 75 others through tissue donation; and

9 WHEREAS, Georgia Donor Week serves as a time to honor donors and their families for the
10 extraordinary generosity that makes transplantation possible; and

11 WHEREAS, this observance also recognizes the dedicated medical teams, recovery
12 organizations, healthcare professionals, and community partners who work tirelessly to
13 support donation and transplantation.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 recognize February 9 to 13, 2026, as Georgia Donor Week at the state capitol and encourage
16 all citizens to learn more about organ donation.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
18 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
19 press.
