A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 5B of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to special districts for transit purposes sales and use tax (Transit SPLOST), so as to  
3 provide for time limits upon the recalling of an election for approval of such special sales and  
4 use tax upon failure to approve; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and  
5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 5B of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
9 special districts for transit purposes sales and use tax (Transit SPLOST), is amended in Code  
10 Section 48-8-269.44, relating to ballot question, expenses of election, resubmission of  
11 question, and general obligation debt for neighboring counties and special districts outside  
12 nonattainment areas, by revising subsection (c) as follows:

13 "(c) Where such question is not approved by the voters, the county may resubmit such  
14 question ~~from time to time~~ upon compliance with the requirements of this article and after  
15 the passage of eight years from the date the special election was previously held."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 Said article is further amended in Code Section 48-8-269.46, relating to ballot question,  
18 expenses of election, resubmission of question, and general obligation debt for special  
19 districts within nonattainment areas, by revising subsection (c) as follows:

20 "(c) Where such question is not approved by the voters, the county may resubmit such  
21 question ~~from time to time~~ upon compliance with the requirements of this article and after  
22 the passage of eight years from the date the special election was previously held."

23 **SECTION 3.**

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
