2 Private State Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Hebron Christian Academy football team, established in 2007, has
4 maintained a proud tradition of excellence with equal emphases on character and academics;

6 WHEREAS, this superlative team has completed another triumphant season of football
7 competition by posting an outstanding record of 12 wins and only one loss; and

8 WHEREAS, the team brought special recognition to its school by winning the 2026 3A-A
9 Private State Championship against Calvary Day School with a final score of 28-21; and

10 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding
11 athletic ability, dedication, hard work, and unity of purpose and spirit of each member of the
12 team; its superb offensive and defensive talents; and the astute direction of Head Coach
13 Kenny Dallas; and

14 WHEREAS, this all-star team included senior wide receiver Jarvis Mathurin, who was
15 named as the game's Most Valuable Player after recording two interceptions on defense,
16 along with 60 rushing yards on four carries with a 58-yard touchdown; senior running back
17 Devon Caldwell, who totaled 85 rushing yards on 25 carries with one touchdown; freshman
18 wide receiver Austin Kitchings, who caught a touchdown pass for 27 yards, totaling 36
19 receiving yards in the game; senior defensive back/wide receiver Max Steve, who recorded
20 8 tackles, one interception, and two pass breakups on defense, while scoring an 11-yard
21 touchdown reception on offense; as well as senior quarterback Gray Costello and junior
22 quarterback Jordan Greene who each threw for one touchdown; and

24 performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, it is
