A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Darvin Eason; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Darvin Eason on February 16, 2026; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Darvin Eason was born on December 11, 1939, in Screven, Georgia, a beloved
5 son of J. B. and Mildred Eason; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Darvin was an active member of Lakeview
7 Baptist Church; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Nancy, and was blessed with
9 two remarkable children, Robbie and Wendy, and many wonderful grandchildren and
10 great-grandchildren; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he served as vice-president of Water for Life Haiti, where he tirelessly guided
12 the group in its mission to provide clean drinking water, irrigation for farming, education,
13 and other means of assistance to the people of southern Haiti; and

14 WHEREAS, Darvin also served as Chairman of the Board and Director Emeritus of the
15 Georgia Agribusiness Council, President of the Georgia Peanut Producer's Association, and
16 Chairman of the Board for South Central Georgia Gin Co.; and

17 WHEREAS, deeply involved in and loving what he did, Darvin was awarded the Blair W.
18 Davis Outstanding Service Award from the Georgia Plant Food Educational Society in 2000
19 and was named Progressive Farmer Magazine's Man of the Year in 1996; and

20 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
22 made this world a better place in which to live; and

23 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Darvin Eason will long be remembered for
24 his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
25 fortune of knowing him.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 join in honoring the life and memory of Darvin Eason and express their deepest and most
28 sincere regret at his passing.
