AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners of Forsyth County, approved
2 June 30, 1964 (Ga. L. 1964 Ex. Sess., p. 2225), as amended, so as to provide term limits for
3 members of the board of commissioners; to provide for related matters; to provide effective
4 dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating a board of commissioners of Forsyth County, approved June 30, 1964
8 (Ga. L. 1964 Ex. Sess., p. 2225), as amended, is amended by adding a new section to read
9 as follows:

10 "SECTION 2.1.

11 No person elected to the board of commissioners after January 1, 2026, who has been
12 elected to and served three full terms of office as a commissioner shall be eligible for
13 election to a successive term of office as a commissioner until after the expiration of four
14 years from the conclusion of his or her last term as a member of the board of
15 commissioners."
