ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing May 2, 2026, as Stilettos on Steel Day and International Female Ride Day at
2 the Georgia State Capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Stilettos on Steel is a national organization whose mission is to unite female
4 motorcyclists of all skill levels for friendship, support, and peer-to-peer or professional
5 learning opportunities that ensure members are knowledgeable and safe motorcycle
6 operators; and

7 WHEREAS, Stilettos on Steel has over 100 dedicated members and six chapters in the state
8 of Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, the Newnan Chapter of Stilettos on Steel was founded in July 2023 and is
10 composed of 44 dedicated members; and

11 WHEREAS, the Newnan Chapter focuses not only on riding and mentorship, but is also
12 actively involved in community through support of the Coweta Samaritan Clinic, Wreaths
13 Across America, City of Hope Patient Assistance Fund, Silver Bells, Marine Toys for Tots,
14 Joey's Toybox, Newnan and Hogansville Police Departments' Shop with a Cop, and the
15 Coweta County Sheriff's Department annual bicycle build-off; and

16 WHEREAS, on May 2, 2026, the Newnan Chapter of Stiletos on Steel will be hosting its
17 signature event, International Female Ride Day; and

18 WHEREAS, the chapter will lead an exclusively all female planned and led ride throughout
19 Coweta, Troup, and Meriwether counties escorted by local law enforcement and all proceeds
20 will be donated to the Coweta County Sheriff's Department for their annual bicycle build-off
21 to purchase bicycles for teenage girls; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to recognize this outstanding organization
23 upon the third anniversary of its signature International Female Ride Day event.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 recognize May 2, 2026, as Stiletos on Steel Day and International Female Ride Day at the
26 Georgia State Capitol.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
28 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Stiletos on Steel
29 of Newnan, Georgia.
