1 Recognizing February 17, 2026, as Next Gen Youth Entrepreneurship Day at the state
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

8 celebrate innovation, creativity, and the power of young entrepreneurs; and

10 the role entrepreneurship plays in strengthening communities while also gaining firsthand

13 knowledge, confidence, and vision needed to turn ideas into impact; and

15 importance of investing in young minds and fostering an entrepreneurial spirit that will help
