A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 11, 2026, as Nurses Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the over 170,000 registered nurses in Georgia comprise the state's largest
3 healthcare profession and are vital to the medical well-being of our citizens; and
- 4 WHEREAS, professional nursing has proven to be an indispensable component for safe,
5 high quality care of hospitalized patients; and
- 6 WHEREAS, professional nurses are also vital to outpatient care of patients, and the renewed
7 emphasis on access to primary and preventative care in recent years will require better
8 utilization of our states registered nursing resources; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the aging of the American Population, increased reduction of healthcare options
10 in rural settings and growth of home healthcare services have led to a greater than ever
11 demand for registered nursing services , and more qualified registered nurses will be needed
12 in the future to meet the increasingly complex needs of health care consumers in Georgia;

14 WHEREAS, the Georgia Nurses Association supports and advocates the many ways in
15 which registered nurses of all levels of education and training strive to provide safe and high
16 quality patient care and map out ways to improve our healthcare system.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body recognize March 11, 2026, as Nurses Day at the state capitol and
19 commend the men and women of our nursing workforce their strength, leadership, and
20 courage in their willingness to find meaning in something greater than themselves.
