A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the 3rd Infantry Division and Brigadier General John W. Lubas and recognizing
2 February 25, 2026, as Fort Stewart–Liberty County Day at the Capitol; and for other
3 purposes.

5 "Rock of the Marne," has served with distinction and valor since its activation in 1917,
6 earning a legacy of courage and sacrifice in major conflicts across the world; and

8 participating in World War I, World War II, the Korean War, Operation Desert Storm,
9 Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, and numerous other missions critical

12 Infantry Division and stands as a cornerstone of national defense, readiness, and global

23 service members and their families; and

24 WHEREAS, Fort Stewart–Liberty County Day at the Capitol provides a meaningful
25 opportunity for state leaders, community stakeholders, and members of the General
26 Assembly to recognize the vital contributions of the 3rd Infantry Division, Brigadier General
27 John W. Lubas, and Deputy Commanding General of Support Kevin D. Bradley to Georgia
28 and the nation.

30 the members of this body honor the 3rd Infantry Division for its historic legacy of excellence,
