### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Lieutenant Colonel (Ret.) Sabrina Keyrra Bradley; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel (Ret.) Sabrina Keyrra Bradley served as a guardian of this  
4 nation's freedom and liberty with the United States Army, valiantly and courageously  
5 protecting her fellow Americans from 1975 to 2005; and

6 WHEREAS, she served in multiple leadership roles, including Emergency Plans and  
7 Operations Officer and Medical Logistics Officer, and commanded a Headquarters Company  
8 during the Gulf War; and

9 WHEREAS, following her retirement from active duty, she continued federal service as a  
10 Hazardous Materials Investigator with the United States Department of Transportation; and

11 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel (Ret.) Bradley has contributed more than 6,000 volunteer  
12 hours supporting veteran and community organizations including Employer Support of the  
13 Guard and Reserve, the National Association of Black Military Women, the Georgia Military  
14 Women, Disabled American Veterans, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the Federal Bureau  
15 of Investigation Citizens Academy Alumni Association; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this extraordinary Georgian be  
17 appropriately honored.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 recognize Lieutenant Colonel (Ret.) Sabrina Keyrra Bradley's unwavering commitment to  
20 volunteerism and community service and commend her for her over 30 years of dedicated  
21 service to her country and state.
