

The House Committee on Judiciary, Juvenile offers the following substitute to HB 1445:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 12 of Article 6 of Chapter 11 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to disposition of delinquency in the juvenile code, so as to authorize
3 sharing of GPS monitoring with law enforcement and school districts; to provide for related
4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Part 12 of Article 6 of Chapter 11 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
8 relating to disposition of delinquency in the juvenile code, is amended by adding a new Code
9 section to read as follows:

10 "15-11-605.1.

11 Upon request by any state or local law enforcement agency or local school system or other
12 public school, the DJJ shall share real-time GPS monitoring and exclusion violations of
13 juvenile offenders with such law enforcement agencies and local school systems or other
14 public schools for any juvenile actively monitored; provided, however, that such law
15 enforcement agency, local school system, or other public school shall first certify to the

16 DJJ that such juvenile offender is physically located within this state or the applicable local
17 school system or other public school."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
