A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Hassan Raheem Glasgow and dedicating a road in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Hassan Raheem Glasgow was born on March 3, 1993, in Key West,
4 Florida, a beloved son of Darlene Mathis and Edward Glasgow; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Glasgow graduated from King's Fork High School in Suffolk, Virginia, and
6 was employed with Emory University as a computer support specialist; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Glasgow gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep
8 concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he
9 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and

10 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
11 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
12 made this world a better place in which to live; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
14 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 540 in Washington County from
17 State Route 231 to the Jefferson County line is dedicated as the Hassan Raheem Glasgow
18 Memorial Highway.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Hassan Raheem Glasgow
21 Memorial Highway.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
23 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
24 family of Mr. Hassan Raheem Glasgow and to the Department of Transportation.
