3 distinguished rank conferred by Scouting America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate her proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and the attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Kaylin Landrian-Shrewsbury has ably evidenced her aptitude and competency in mastering
9 the various special skills taught through the Scouts BSA program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Kaylin Landrian-Shrewsbury is an honor student at Mill Creek High School in
11 Hoschton, Georgia, where she is scheduled to graduate this summer; and
- 12 WHEREAS, she is an accomplished musician who plays the violin in her school orchestra
13 and aspires to study biology at the University of North Georgia with the goal of becoming
14 a biology teacher; and

15 WHEREAS, Kaylin Landrian-Shrewsbury is among the first female Scouts within Scouting
16 America as well as a founding member of Troop 5508, one of the first female troops
17 established within the Northeast Georgia Council; and

18 WHEREAS, her scouting achievements include in-depth studies in first aid, health,
19 environmental sustainability, forestry, and mammal studies, along with numerous additional
20 career and recreational skill related merit badges; and

21 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Kaylin Landrian-Shrewsbury has truly exhibited a
22 commitment to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently
23 conducted herself in a manner becoming of an Eagle Scout; and

24 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
25 has set an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young woman's
26 future.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body commend Kaylin Landrian-Shrewsbury for her diligence and
29 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by Scouting America and congratulate her
