1 Congratulating and commending Lady Libby J. Pollard for receiving the 2026 Yellow Rose
2 Nikki T. Randall Servant Leadership Award; and for other purposes.

4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Women's Legislative Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Women's Legislative
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Lady Libby J. Pollard, affectionately and respectfully known as Lady Libby,
11 is a proud Atlanta native and graduate of Hoke Smith High School and Draughons College
12 in Atlanta, Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, in June 1991, she was united in Holy Matrimony to Dr. Gregory L. Pollard,
14 Senior Pastor of the Enon Church in Atlanta, Georgia, and together, they have been blessed
15 with two daughters of the King, Gabrielle Elayndra and Danielle Cartier; and

16 WHEREAS, after a distinguished 20-year career in the medical field, Lady Libby
17 transitioned into full-time ministry alongside Pastor Pollard; and

18 WHEREAS, Lady Libby is the driving force behind Enon's Health and Wellness Ministry,
19 where she has partnered with ministry leaders and healthcare professionals to host on-site
20 community events providing flu and COVID-19 vaccinations, health screenings, and blood
21 drives to the South Fulton community; and

22 WHEREAS, she currently serves as Co-Church Administrator, providing daily operational
23 oversight and strategic leadership to the ministry, serving the congregation and surrounding
24 communities with excellence, grace, and diligence; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
26 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body congratulate and commend Lady Libby J. Pollard for receiving the
