## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Veroniece P. Marable for 41 years of distinguished service in education; and for  
2 other purposes.

4 of education in the Atlanta area, demonstrating unwavering dedication, integrity, and an  
5 enduring commitment to the success of students; and

6 WHEREAS, throughout her distinguished career, she has consistently modeled excellence  
7 in instruction and leadership, earning the honor of being named Teacher of the Year on two  
8 occasions in recognition of her outstanding impact on student achievement and professional  
9 excellence; and
