6 confidence, and purpose; and
- 7 WHEREAS, she is a senior at Central Fine Arts and International Baccalaureate Magnet  
8 High School in Macon, Georgia, where she is a violinist in the Orchestra Magnet Program;

- 10 WHEREAS, Kennedy is an active member of FBLA and DECA, a dedicated student-athlete  
11 in flag football and soccer, and a dual-enrollment student who has earned a Technical  
12 Certificate in Early College Essentials from Central Georgia Technical College; and

16 maintains a cumulative GPA of 3.9; and
